Fabric B: FISF 4101 MU	5/8 yard
Fabric C: FISF 4102 MU	1 yard
Fabric D: FISF 4103 T	7/8 yard
Fabric E: FISF 4105 LB	7/8 yard
Fabric F: FISF 4106 J	2/3 yard
Fabric G: SUED 300 K	2 1/8 yards
Fabric H: SUED 300 S	Fat Eighth
Backing: FISF 4100 MU suggested	5 yards
Batting	73" x 87"

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

From Fabric A:

1. Cut three 9 1/2" strips; subcut ten 9 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

From Fabric B:

1. Cut seven 2 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 2 1/2" x 62" strips and two 2 1/2" x 71 1/2" strips. (Middle Border)

From Fabric C:

1. Cut three 9 1/2" strips; subcut ten 9 1/2" squares. (Blocks)

From Fabric D:

1. Cut seven 3 1/2" strips; subcut twenty 3 1/2" x 12 7/8" rectangles. Cut left end of rectangles at 45-degree angle as shown in Figure 1. (Blocks)

From Fabric E:

1. Cut two 12 7/8" strips; subcut twenty 12 7/8" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Cut right end of rectangles at 45-degree angle as shown in Figure 2. (Blocks)

From Fabric F:

1. Cut eight 2 1/2" strips. (Binding)

From Fabric G:

1. Cut seven 1 1/2" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 1 1/2" x 58" strips and two 1 1/2" x 69 1/2" strips. (Inner Border)
2. Cut seventeen 2" strips; subcut forty-nine 2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. (Sashing)
3. Cut eight 3" strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams. Press seams open. From this pieced strip, cut two 3" x 67" strips and two 3" x 75 1/2" strips. (Outer Border) Note: this border has been cut extra wide and will be trimmed after quilting.

From Fabric H:

1. Cut thirty 2" squares. (Sashing Squares)

Piecing Instructions:

1. Aligning straight edges, sew one 3 1/2" x 12 7/8" E shape to the left side of one 9 1/2" A square. Stop sewing at the 1/4" seam point at the opposite end of the square (or just before that point). Press away from the square.
2. Repeat Step 1 but sew one 3 1/2" x 12 7/8" D shape to the bottom of the A square.

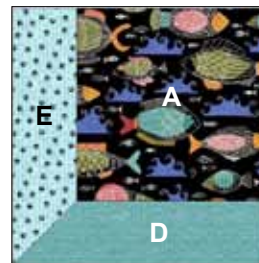


Figure 3 Make 10.

3. Beginning at the inside and sewing to the outer edge, close angled ends of the E and D shapes with a mitered seam. Press seam open. Repeat to make ten blocks (Figure 3).

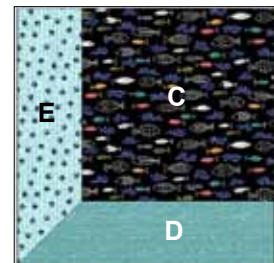


Figure 4 Make 10.

4. Repeat Steps 1-3 using 9 1/2" C squares (Figure 4).

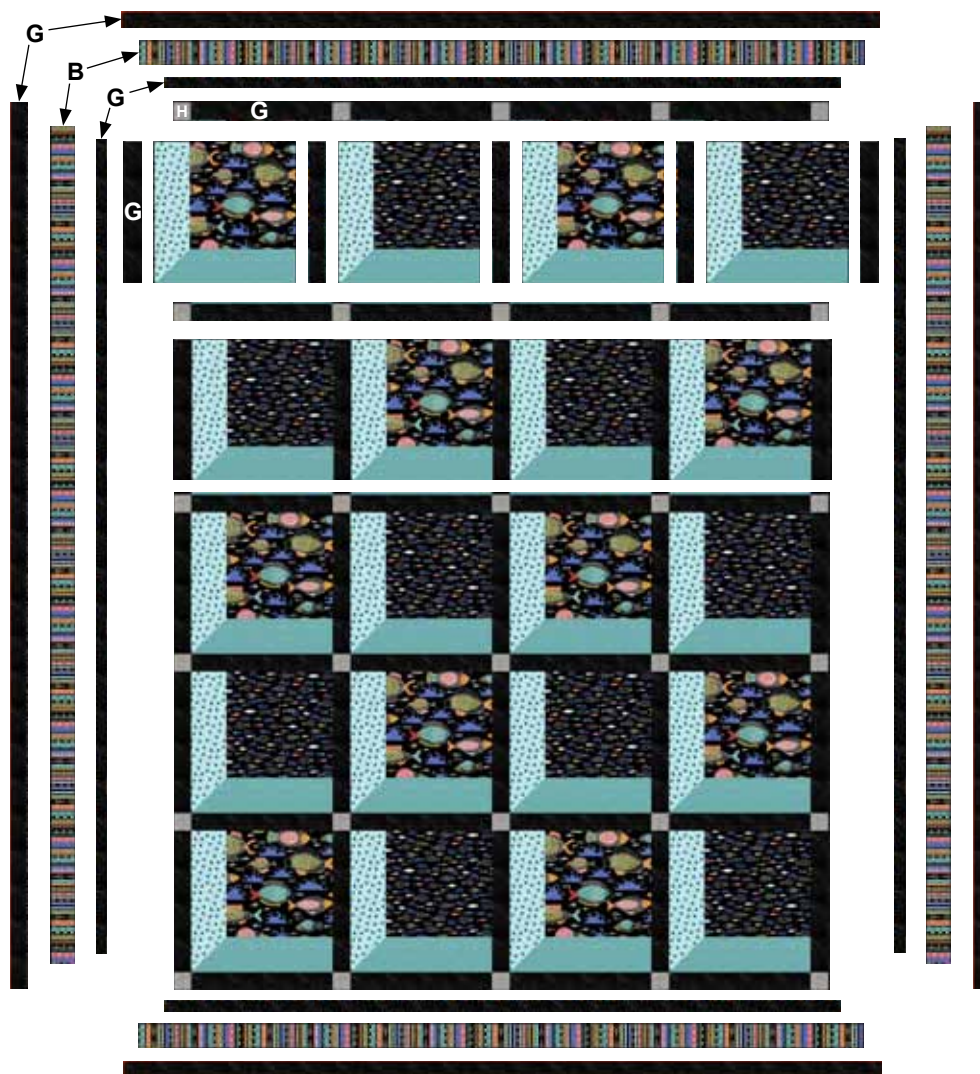
Quilt Assembly:

1. Refer to quilt diagram to lay blocks into rows alternating the A and C blocks. To create block rows, sew one 2" x 12 1/2" G rectangle between each block and one G rectangle to the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the G rectangles.
2. To create one sashing row, sew four 2" x 12 1/2" G rectangles alternately with five 2" H squares. Press toward the rectangles. Repeat to make six sashing rows.

3. Sew block rows and sashing rows together alternating the rows. Press toward the sashing rows or press open.
4. Sew one 1 1/2" x 69 1/2" G strip to both sides of the quilt. Press seams toward the strips. Sew one 1 1/2" x 58" G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams toward the strips.
5. Sew one 2 1/2" x 71 1/2" B strip to both sides of the quilt. Press seams toward the strips. Sew one 2 1/2" x 62" B strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams toward the strips.
6. Sew one 3" x 75 1/2" G strip to both sides of the quilt. Press seams toward the strips. Sew one 3" x 67" G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams toward the strips.

Finishing:

1. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with vertical seam/s. Press seams open. Trim backing to 73" x 87".
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Since outer borders were cut across the width of the fabric, some stretching may have occurred in the quilting process. The quilt was designed with 1 1/2" finished borders but were cut as 3" strips to compensate for the stretching. If you also want 1 1/2" finished borders, trim 1 3/4" from the seam line on all sides squaring all corners.
5. Join 2 1/2" F binding strips with diagonal seams. Press seams open. Attach binding to quilt using your favorite method.
6. Make a label and sew to the back of the quilt.
