

Constructing Cat Blocks

1. Top Section. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **H** square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **H** corner triangle. Repeat with another $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **H** square at the opposite corner along the same long side of the same **A** rectangle.



1a. Add (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " **H** rectangle to the bottom of previously sewn unit to make head unit, measuring $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge.



1b. Add to the left (in this case) or right of the previously sewn head unit (1) 3½" A square.






1c. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **H** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle.








2. Sew together units made in Steps 1b and 1c to complete (1) cat block, measuring 6½" x 6½" raw edge to raw edge.

3. Make a total number of blocks with head on right side for the following fabric prints:

(4) blocks: C, E, N, P, R, U, AA

(3) blocks: **O**, **J**, **M**

(2) blocks: T, H, B, F, G, I, Q, V, W, Y, Z,


(1) block: **L, S, X**

3a. Make a total number of blocks with head on left side for the following **fabric prints**:

(1) block: L, T, O, D,H


4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1" **A** square. Place square, RST, at top left corner of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **K** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " **A** square at the top right corner of the same **K** rectangle, and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** square at the bottom left corner of the same **K** rectangle to complete half a heart unit.







5. Repeat to make a mirror-image of the previously sewn unit. Then sew together to make a heart unit.





6. Sew (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** rectangles to the opposite sides of heart unit, followed by (2) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of heart unit to complete (1) heart block.





- 7. Make a total number of blocks for the following fabric prints:
- (3) blocks: **K**
- (2) blocks: **L**



8. Pieced Rows. Using the diagrams on Pages 7-8, arrange and sew together (8) blocks to make a pieced row. Make a total of (9) rows.

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7, 9: (7) cat blocks and (1) heart block.


Rows 2, 4, 6, 8: (8) cat blocks.

9. Sew together pieced rows and (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " A sashing strips to complete quilt center.

10. Inner Border. Sew (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $52\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

11. Outer Border. Sew (2) $3'' \times 66\frac{1}{2}''$ **AB** strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) $3'' \times 57\frac{1}{2}''$ **AB** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Finishing

12. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich.

13. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired.

14. Bind with Fabric M to finish quilt.
