This blanke consists of **fabrics**, **decorations**, **sewing**, and **edging**. Among the fabrics, there are four types of them. Crochet all the fabri pieces, attach the correspnding decortions, sew the fabrics all together, and edge around the perimeter.

Note:

- 1. This pattern is written using American terminology. All measurements in charts are in cm.
- 2. When crocheting in rounds without further guidance, working in **closed** rounds, start each round with a set number of beginning chains and close with a slip stitch. The beginning chain preceding a single crochet and the slip stitch used for joining rounds are not included in the total stitches.

Materials: 4-Ply Combed Cotton & Acrylic Fibre Hand Knitting Yarn Hook: 3.0mm hook

The handcrafted measurements may have an error of 1 to 2cm. Due to variations in individual tension, the size of the sample is for reference only.

The upper four car motifs are in Case 2; the lower four car motifs are in Case 1.

- √ hdc2-in-1: 2 half double crochets into the same stitch
- ch3-picot: chain 3 and then join with one slip stitch into both the front loop of the previous stitch and the front leg strand of the previous stitch.

- dc2-in-1: 2 double crochets into the same stitch
 - dc2-bobble: double crochet 2 stitches into the same stitch and
 - crocheted together
- dc2tog: double crochet 2 stitches together
- blo-dc: double crochet through the back loop only
- dc3-bobble: double crochet 3 stitches into the same stitch and crocheted together
- 5-dc popcorn: 5 double crochets popcorn

STEP1 Fabric 1 A and Fabric 2 B


Both of Fabric 1 and Fabric 2 are started with an adjustable magic ring, and crocheted cunterclockwise. Pay attention to the color changing in the last 3 rounds of Fabric 2. Please refer to the video demonstration for more details.

- 1. Only Fabric 2 requires changing the color of yarn. Here in the graphic, stitch symbols in black refers to Color 1, stitch symbols in blue refers to Color 2.
- 2. Once you finish a fabric, be sure to measure the length of sides. If there is great difference, you need to adjust your tension or change the size of your hook and redo it.
- 3. Tree motifs and car motifs are crocheted separately and sewed onto the fabrics






STEP2 Fabric 3 C

Fabric 3 is started with an adjustable magic ring, and crocheted cunterclockwise. Pay attention to the particular positions to insert your hook in Round 4 and 5. Please refer to the video demonstration for more details.




STEP4 Decorations

The decorations include the trees **E1**, cars **E2** wheels, and leaves **E3** Crochet them separately and sew them onto corresponding positions. Then, crochet stems and sew leaves on Fabric 3. Lastly, sew and crochet the correspoding decoraions **E4** on Fabric 4. Please refer to the video demonstration for more details.

- 1. In Round 3, crochet 4 single crochets and 1 ch3-picot at each corner while crochet 5 single crochets and 1 ch3-picot on each side. If there is stitch difference between your work and the pattern, you can adjust the amount of single stitches between ch3-picots.
- 2. When you done with your edging, you can iron it for better appearance.
