

Jasmine Stitch Crochet Pattern

The Jasmine Stitch is a beautiful and textured crochet stitch that creates soft, flower-like clusters. Perfect for blankets, scarves, and cozy accessories, this stitch adds an elegant floral touch to your handmade pieces. It's a dense, puffy pattern that starts without a foundation chain, making it unique and enjoyable to work on.

Materials

- Yarn: Soft medium-weight or fine yarn (cotton, acrylic, or bamboo blends)
- Hook: Use a crochet hook slightly larger than recommended for your yarn
- Scissors and tapestry needle for finishing

Stitches Used

Incomplete Half Double Crochet (hdc): Yarn over, draw a loop through the base stitch, and pull both loops slightly upward (3 loops on hook).

Puff Stitch: Chain 1, extend loop on the hook (1 inch tall), make 2 incomplete hdc in same stitch (5 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through all loops, chain 1 to fasten.

Group of 3 Puffs: Chain 1, extend loop (first hdc), make 2 incomplete hdc in last eyelet (5 loops), 3 incomplete hdc in previous stitch (11 loops), 3 incomplete hdc in next stitch (17 loops), yarn over, draw through all loops, chain 1 to fasten.

Pattern Instructions

Round 1: Start with a slip knot. No foundation chain required. Work 1 puff in the initial stitch. *1 puff in the closing eyelet of the previous puff.* Repeat until desired width.

Round 2: Work 1 puff, then *1 group of 3 puffs.* Repeat to the end. Turn.

Next Rounds: Always repeat Round 2. Each flower will form 6 petals radiating from the center, except the first one.

Tips for Success

- Keep your tension loose so the puffs stay full and even.
- Maintain consistent loop height for a neat appearance.
- Block gently after finishing to shape the flowers.
- The Jasmine Stitch uses more yarn than basic stitches, so plan extra yarn for larger projects.

Project Ideas

- Baby blankets or throws
- Elegant scarves and wraps
- Pillow covers with floral texture
- Warm winter accessories like hats or cowls
